1) Measurement frameworks

Some of the ongoing processes:

- Updated Performance Framework (PF)
- HSS & CSS measurement frameworks
- Most-At-Risk populations. Draft Operational guidelines for M&E (MSM and IDUs in draft)
- WHO global task force on TB impact measurement
- Quality of services
- Evaluation
- Gender Equality and SOGI
- Impact/outcome

2) Data quality

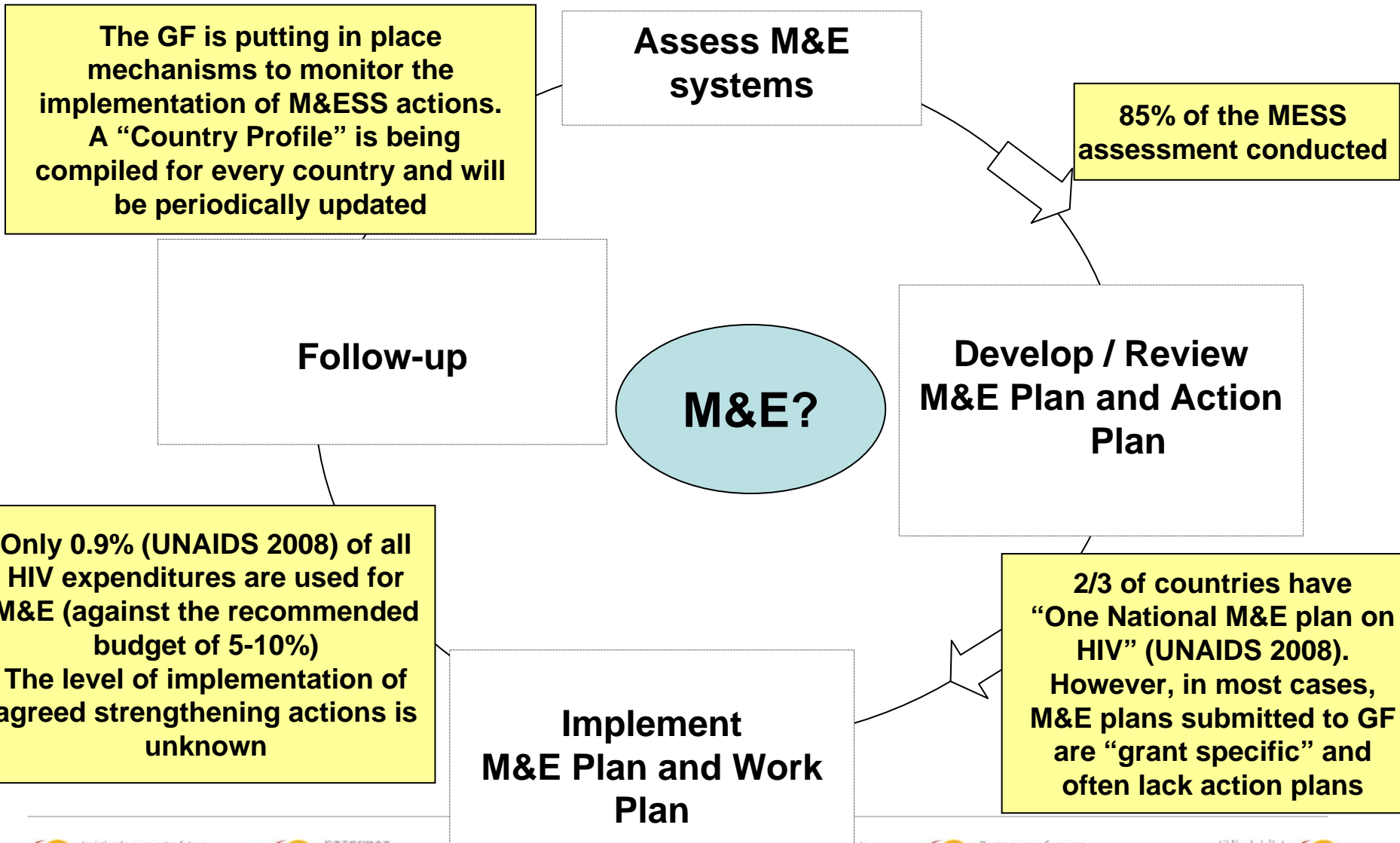
Achieved so far:

- OSDV - over 168 (40%) of grants underwent as of Q3
(Target for 2009: 80%)
- Data Quality Audits conducted in 20 countries
(7 ongoing to be finalized by end of 2009)
- Some of the recommendations from OSDV and DQA are translated in:
 - Condition Precedents and Time Bound actions in the Agreements;
 - Management actions (FPM to follow-up)
 - Follow-up actions in the M&E Country Profiles (M&E officer to follow-up)
- Routine Data Quality Audit tool is made available

Ongoing:

- Data quality strategy is under development

3) M&E system strengthening

Other important updates:

- a) The work on HSS and CSS goes beyond building a measurement framework and is expected to lead to more investments in (M&E) system strengthening
- b) Partnerships are being strengthened to provide more assistance in this area (e.g. MOUs with WHO, UNAIDS, RBM, StopTB, etc.)
- c) UNAIDS 12 components tool in HIV is in some cases replacing M&ESS tool in HIV programmes

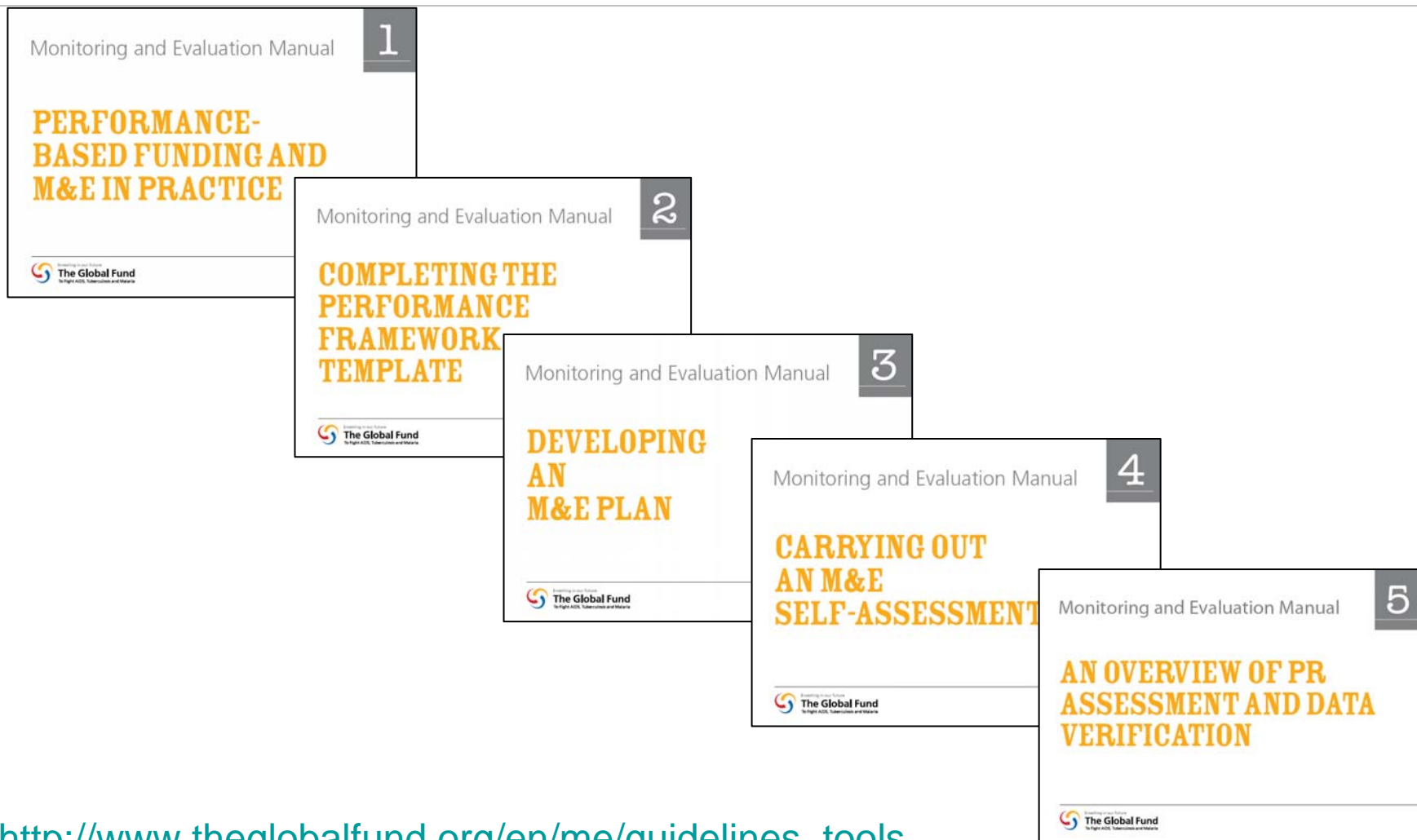
